Secondary Exams

Exams begin this week for secondary students.

Important Reminders:

- Exams are not rescheduled for vacations or work.
- If a student is ill for an exam, parents need to contact the school to verify the absence and make a plan
- Exams may need to be moved due to Inclement Weather days so it is important that students are available on all of the exam days from January 25 - 31.
- If buses are cancelled during exams due to Inclement Weather, all exams on that day will be cancelled and the entire exam schedule will shifted one day. For Example, if Friday's buses are cancelled, Friday's exams are moved to Monday, Monday's to Tuesday and so on.
- Buses will run following the North and South Late Bus routes each day at 11:30am. If students are unable to take the bus home, they will need to be in the library for quiet study.
